What iMM seeks: At this moment, iMM is looking for a Research Assistant to join the Dermatology Laboratory coordinated by Paulo Filipe PhD, under the research project "*The IL-23/IL-17 axis and angiogenesis in non-melanoma skin cancer*", funded by Almirall, S.A., to <u>execute the following activities</u> under the supervision of João Ferreira MD, PhD, and Daniela Cunha, MD:

- Bsc or Master's degree in Life Sciences (eg, Pathology, Biology, Biochemistry);
- Highly motivated to pursue a research project;
- Experience in basic laboratory skills;
