What iMM seeks: At this moment, iMM is looking for a Clinical Researcher to join the Biobanco-iMM CAML coordinated by Professors Sérgio Dias and Cláudia Faria, under the research project "Coleção de Tumores", funded by Liga Portuguesa Contra o Cancro, to execute the following activities under the supervision of Sérgio Dias:

- Collection of clinical data, with special focus on the "Tumors" collection;
- Maintenance of clinical information in the LIMS database of the Biobanco-iMM CAML;
- Creation of clinical questionnaires and introduction of new clinical variables;
- Creation of missing data reports and progression of information registration.

Profile of Candidate

What iMM offers: iMM will offer outstanding working conditions in this area in Portugal, including a full-time contract, starting predictably in March / April 2023, and the possibility to work in the interface of research and research support facilities.

Working Conditions: 12 months unfixed-term employment contract; Gross monthly salary of €1.120 approximately, in accordance with the project budget and iMM Career By-Law plus meal allowance for each working day in the daily amount of 5,20€. Also, to the candidate will be paid Holidays and Christmas allowances. The indicated amount will be subject to the mandatory taxes accordingly to Portuguese Labor Law.

Evaluation Criteria: Applications will be evaluated by Sérgio Dias, Sandra Casimiro and Ângela Afonso, in accordance with the following method:

- 1st Phase: Curricular evaluation: 40% and Motivation Letter: 20%;
- 2nd Phase: Interview: 40%. Only candidates that scored at least 50% in 1st Phase will be selected for an interview.

Results: Both admitted and excluded candidates list and final classification list shall be posted at iMM website at https://imm.medicina.ulisboa.pt/jobs/#results and all admitted candidates will be notified by email.

Preliminary Hearing and Final Decision Deadline: After notification, all candidates have 10 working days to respond. Panel's final decisions are pronounced within a period of 90 days, from application deadline.

The present call is exclusively aimed at filling the indicated vacancy and may be terminated until the homologation of the final candidates' ranking list and expires with the respective occupation of the position on offer.
