**CALL FOR A TECHNICAL RESEARCH FELLOWSHIP
Reference of Fellowship IMM/BTI/143/2016**

Instituto de Medicina Molecular (iMM Lisboa) opens a call for a Technical Research Fellowship under the project EMBO Installation Grant.

Work Plan and Goals:

- To perform biochemical techniques (ChIP; qPCR; RNA extraction and purification; Comet assays; etc.)
- To perform immunofluorescence and confocal microscopy
- To maintain human cell lines in culture

Scientific Area: Biochemistry; Molecular and Cell Biology

Candidate's Profile:

- Degree in Biochemistry, molecular biology or related areas.
- Full time experience in a research lab
- Knowledge of confocal microscopy and culture of human cell lines

Duration of Fellowship: 3 (three) months on an exclusive basis, eventually renewable, not exceeding the eligible period of the project.

Law and Regulation:

Research Fellowship Statute (Law nr 40/2004, from August 18th, republished in attach to Decree-Law nr 202/2012, from August 27th), Fundação para a Ciência e a Tecnologia (FCT) Regulation Fellowship in force (www.fct.pt/apoios/bolsas/docs/RegulamentoBolsasFCT2015.pdf) and iMM Lisboa Regulation Fellowship and IMM Career By-Law.

WorkPlace and Scientific Orientation: The work will be developed at **SAlmeida and EGomes Labs**, of iMM Lisboa, under the supervision of Sérgio de Almeida, PhD and Edgar Gomes, PhD.

Fellow Monitoring Centre: The monitoring centre works on Tuesday and Thursday from 10am to 12pm, at Human Resources of iMM Lisbon.

Monthly Remuneration: 745€ according to the values defined directly by FCT Regulation Fellowship in force (<http://www.fct.pt/apoios/bolsas/valores>). The amount will be paid through bank transfer, at the end of the month.

Necessary Documents for Applications:

- Detailed CV;
- Copy of Academic Certificate Degree;
- Motivation letter

The not complying with these requirements determines the immediate rejection of the application.

Evaluation: Applications will be evaluated by a jury composed by Professor Sérgio de Almeida, Professor Edgar Gomes and Ana Rita Grosso (all PhD's).

Selection Method: The candidate will be selected after detailed analysis of the CV and motivation (100%). If necessary, selected candidates will be shortlisted for an interview. In this case, the evaluation will be 75% for curricular evaluation and 25% for interview.

Deadlines and Presentation of Applications

The call will be open for 10 working days, **starting on December 9th and ending on December 20th, 2016**
