Instituto de Medicina Molecular (iMM Lisboa) opens a call for a Science and Technology Management Fellowship with the funding support from European Union's Horizon 2020 Framework Programme for Research and Innovation within the project entitled "***Repair of tissue and organ damage in refractory chronic graft versus host disease after hematopoietic stem cell transplantation by infusion of purified allogeneic donor regulatory T lymphocytes***".

Work Plan and Goals

- Management of the EC funded consortium TREGeneration involving clinical Trials and coordinated in Lisbon
- Management responsibilities within the research group of the Coordinator of the above mentioned project

Scientific Area: Health Sciences

Profile of Candidate

- PhD degree in the health or life sciences
- Excellent domain of the English language, both spoken and written
- Dynamic profile, demonstrated by relevant leadership activities and scientific interactions
- Preference given to demonstrated experience in the management of European research projects

Duration: 12 (twelve) months on an exclusive basis, eventually renewable for equal periods not exceeding the period of eligibility of the project.

Selection Method: Curriculum evaluation 40% - Interview 60%. In the interview may be requested to candidates a practical demonstration with an EXCEL database, which will have a maximum valuation of 20%.

Deadline and Submission of Applications: The call will be opened for 10 (ten) business days, **starting on June 13, and ending on June 24, 2016.**
