**CALL FOR THREE TECHNICAL RESEARCH FELLOWSHIP
Reference of Fellowships IMM/BTI/16-2016, IMM/BTI/17-2016 and IMM/BTI/18-2016**

Instituto de Medicina Molecular (iMM Lisboa) opens a call for three Technical Research Fellowships with the funding support from FCT/MEC through national funds and when applicable co-funded by FEDER within the new Partnership Agreement PT2020 under project **LISBOA-01-0145-FEDER-007391**.

Work Plan and Goals

Selected candidates will perform tasks related to the routine care of laboratory rodents, participating in all daily maintenance activities, such as:

- Weekly cage changes
- Sanitization of housing and enrichment materials
- Reception and housing of new animals
- checking and re-stocking all used materials
- Daily monitoring of animals
- Support to the colony management activities
- Support to the health monitoring programs
- Cleaning of all rodent facility areas

Scientific Area: Laboratory animal science

Candidate's Profile

- No academic degree / Undergraduate
- Basic IT skills
- Motivated to work with animals and in a scientific environment
- Motivated to work as part of a team
- Good communication skills

Preference will be given to candidates with:

- Previous experience in a similar position
- Complete secondary education
- Basic knowledge of the English language (written and spoken)
- Education in Laboratory Animal Science

Duration of Fellowship: 6 months on an exclusive basis and eventually renewable for equal periods, not exceeding the eligible period of the project.

In this amount FCT will only pay 565€ and according to Career By-Law and Assessment Regulation of iMM Lisboa, the remaining amount will be in charge of iMM Lisboa.
The amount will be paid through bank transfer.

Evaluation: Applications will be evaluated by a jury composed by Professors Henrique Veiga Fernandes, João Pedro Simas and Joana Marques (all PhD's). Iolanda Moreira, Carlos Silva and Pedro Santos, may be called upon as replacement or complement of the original jury.

Selection Method: CV (50%) and interview (50%).

Deadlines and Submission of Applications: The call will be open for 10 working days, **starting on March 14 and ending on March 28, 2016.**
