CALL FOR A POSTDOCTORAL RESEARCH FELLOWSHIP Reference of Fellowship IMM/BPD/22-2019

The Instituto de Medicina Molecular João Lobo Antunes (iMM) opens a call for a **Senior Postdoctoral Research Fellowship**, with the funding support from **GammaDelta Therapeutics**, under the project “GDT – Research Agreement”.

Work Plan and Goals

- Co-supervision of research in the area of Immunology;
- Performance of cellular and molecular assays with T lymphocytes;
- Presentation of results in the written and oral form.

The main scientific goal is the identification of tumor ligands involved in target recognition by human gamma-delta T cells.

Scientific Area: Immunology

Candidate's Profile

- Long experience (minimum of 5 years), including a PhD, in Immunology;
- Broad expertise with assays to study human T lymphocytes;
- Large experience with flow cytometry analysis;
- At least 5 publications in peer-reviewed international journals with impact factor > 5.

Duration of Fellowship: 8 (eight) months on an exclusive basis and eventually renewable, not exceeding the eligible period of the project.

Law and Regulation: Research Fellowship Statute (Law nr 40/2004, from August 18th, republished in attach to Decree-Law nr 202/2012, from August 27th), iMM Regulation Fellowship and iMM Lisboa Career By-Law.

Evaluation: Applications will be evaluated by a jury composed by Professors Bruno Silva-Santos, Luís Graça and Karine Serre (all PhD's)

Selection Method: CV (80%), including publications (50%) and relevant experience (30%); and motivation letter (20%).

Deadlines and Submission of Applications: The call will be open for 10 working days, starting on **10th April and ending on 24th April 2019**.
