The Instituto de Medicina Molecular (iMM Lisboa) opens a call for a Technical Research Fellowship funded by the **European Research Council**, under the project "**AXIAL.EC - PRINCIPLES OF AXIAL POLARITY-DRIVEN VASCULAR PATTERNING**", coordinated by Claudio Franco.

Work Plan and Goals

- Genotyping;
- Production of reagents and solutions.
- Cloning and preparation of viral particles.
- Participate in several scientific activities in the laboratory, including cell culture, immunohistochemistry and microscopy.

Scientific Area: Cell and Molecular Biology

Candidate's Profile

- Highly motivated BSc in the field of Biological, Biochemical or related area;
- Good informatics skills
- Excellent knowledge of English, spoken and written
- Good Communication skills

Duration of Fellowship: **6 (six) months** on an exclusive basis, eventually **renewable for equal periods** not exceeding the eligible period of the project.

Law and Regulation: Research Fellowship Statute (Law nr 40/2004, from August 18th, republished in attach to Decree-Law nr 202/2012, from August 27th), iMM Regulation Fellowship and iMM Lisboa Career By-Law.

Monthly Remuneration: The **net monthly remuneration is 745€**, according to the applicable regulation. The amount will be paid through bank transfer.

Obligatory Documents for Applications: - Motivation letter; - Detailed CV; - 1 Recommendation Letter or Contact information of one reference; - Bachelor degree certificate.

Evaluation: Applications will be evaluated by a jury composed by Edgar Gomes, Nuno Morais and Cláudio Franco (all PhD's).

Selection Method: All applications will be evaluated in accordance with the following valuation:

- Curriculum Vitae (25%)
- Motivation letter (10%)
- Information from the referee(s) (15%)
- After evaluation of all applications up to 5 candidates will be selected to interview (50%).

Deadlines and Submission of Applications: The call will be open on **18th of July and ending on 31st of July of 2017**.
