Instituto de Medicina Molecular João Lobo Antunes (iMM) opens a call for an Initiation Research Fellowship for Master degree with the funding support from LaCaixa Foundation under the project "Fighting Zika virus with antiviral peptides and conjugates translocating blood-placental and blood-brain barriers".

## **Work Plan and Goals**

- Evaluation of the translocation capacity and toxicity of the porphyrin-CPP conjugates in cell lines
- In vitro testing of the efficiency of porphyrin-CPP conjugates in inactivating ZIKV
- Cell viability assays related to infectious diseases

## Candidate's Profile

- Master degree holder in biological or chemical sciences, preferably Biochemistry; enrolled in a Doctoral study cycle;
- More than 5 years full time dedication to research, preferably in infection and/or drug development;
- Experience in microscopy techniques;
- Good knowledge of English, spoken and written;
- Good communication skills, including participation in outreach activities;

**IMPORTANT NOTE:** In the event the Master degree was awarded by a foreigner higher institution, the degree must comply with the provisions of Decree-Law nr 66/2018, 18th August, and all formalities established there must be fulfilled by applications deadline.

Duration of Fellowships: 6 (six) months on an exclusive basis, eventually renewable for equal periods, not exceeding the eligibility period of the project.

Selection Method: The selection will be made by curricular evaluation (50%) and letter of motivation (10%). Only the top ranked candidates will be selected for an interview (40%).

Deadlines and Submission of Applications: The call will be open for 10 working days, starting on 3<sup>rd</sup> April and ending on 17<sup>th</sup> April 2020.
