What iMM seeks: At this moment iMM is looking for a Purchases and Procurement Technician to join the Purchases and Procurement Department, part of Finance and Operations Office, coordinated by Fausto Lopo de Carvalho within funding reference *UIDB/50005/2020* supported by FCT / MCTES through national funds (PIDDAC), to execute the following activities under the supervision of Alexandre Jesus:

- Analysis of previous records and acquisition trends;
- Search for new products and suppliers;
- Supplier negotiation;
- Purchase order registration with researchers and accounting software;
- Stock check and entry for products, services and equipment;
- Management of acquisition non-conformities;
- Import and export process management;
- Information exchange/problem resolution with other departments, specifically accounting and project management.

Profile of Candidate

- Exact science University degree (BSc degree);
- Intermediary to advanced English knowledge, spoken and written;
- Microsoft Office knowledge, mainly excel;
- Valued knowledge of laboratory material and functioning of a research institution;
- Valued knowledge in Microsoft Dynamics NAV;
- Dynamism, team spirit, high sense of responsibility, organization and method;
- Work capacity and focus despite interruptions.

IMPORTANT NOTE: In the event University /BSc degree was awarded by a foreigner higher institution, the degree must comply with the provisions of Decree-Law nr 66/2018, 18th August, and all formalities established there must be fulfilled by applications deadline.

What iMM offers: iMM will offer outstanding working conditions in this area in Portugal, including a full-time contract, starting predictably in April or May 2022, and the possibility to work in support to research.

Working Conditions: Term employment contract; - Gross monthly salary of 1.100€, in accordance with the project budget and iMM Career By-Law. The indicated amount will be subject to the mandatory taxes accordingly to Portuguese Labor Law.

- 1st Phase: Curriculum Evaluation: 30% and Motivation Letter: 15%;
- 2nd Phase: Interview: 55%.

In the event of a tie, the decision will be responsibility of the chairman of the jury.

Preliminary Hearing and Final Decision Deadline: After notification, all candidates have 10 working days to respond. Panel's final decisions are pronounced within a period of 90 days, from application deadline.
